

# RCBA Children's Camp Policies

All campers must have a completed Camper Registration and COVID-19 Waiver form, signed by a parent or legal guardian, in order to participate in camp.

ALL MEDICINE (prescription and over the counter) must be turned into the nurse upon arrival at camp. All prescription medications must be in the original container from the pharmacy and must have the campers name and instructions clearly labeled on the container.

Attire should be appropriate for campers, supervisors and counselors. No tank tops, see-through garments, bikinis, crop-tops may be worn. No clothing with inappropriate messages or advertisements for alcohol or tobacco may be worn. Shorts should be at least mid-thigh in length. Bandannas or caps should not be worn in the dining hall or worship time.

Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times except when in the pool or dorm.

All campers must be covered with their towels or cover-ups when going to and from the swimming pool.

Cell phone use is to be limited. You may not use your cell phone during any planned activity unless otherwise notified during that activity. Cell phones may not be used in bathroom and shower areas. Cabin leaders may establish additional rules regarding cell phone usage as needed.

No camper may leave the camp without permission of the camp director or church supervisor. A legal guardian ONLY will be authorized to take a child from camp. That legal guardian must be listed on the camper's registration form, prior to camp.

Campers are required to be present at all program sessions and meals. Campers are expected to be on time to all planned activities.

Dorms and grounds are to be kept clean at all times.

Food and drinks are not allowed in the tabernacle (or other facilities where worship service is held) or in teaching rooms.

Campers must be in their dorms and have lights out at the times designated in the camp schedule.

There will be no visitors of the opposite gender in any dorm at any time.

Fireworks or not permitted on the campground.

Tobacco (in any form), Alcohol, Drugs or Weapons are strictly prohibited.

Campers shall not exhibit any public display of affection.

Any unregistered guest must report to the Camp Director immediately upon arrival to the camp.
